Review of November Meeting Minutes

• The minutes of the November 2017 vestry meeting were reviewed for accuracy and approved, following a motion to approve by Dorothy Lyons and a second by Betty Best.

Treasurer's Report

- Treasurer Christian Iversen reviewed the November 2017 monthly finance report. See Appendix A of Meeting Minutes for summary of the revenues and expenses. Month-to-date spending was \$13,825.55 above revenue (i.e. deficit). Year-to-date, spending is \$14,756.83 above revenue (i.e. deficit). The finance report was accepted following a motion by Jason Kniss, and a second by Roy Haley.
- The number of monthly kiosk transactions since November 2016 is included in Appendix B of the Meeting Minutes.
- 2018 pledges through today (December 12) totaled \$531,060.00 from 115 pledgers. Additional pledges are expected in the coming weeks.
- The proposed 2018 budget was discussed. The budget is based on \$666,750.00 in revenue and \$664,714.38 in expenses.

MOTION: Accept the 2018 budget as presented and amended at the meeting. The motion came out of the Finance Committee, so does not require a second. The motion passed.

Rector's Report

• Fr. Paul shared the advent schedule, which will be published in the bulletin. Greening of the Church will occur on December 23, which is Saturday. Participation is encouraged.

- Calvary's Annual Church Meeting will be held on January 21, 2018. Fr. Paul shared the agenda and assigned individuals to write reports for inclusion in the Annual Report.
- The Annual Vestry Retreat is scheduled for February 2 (evening) and February 3. A representative from Attack Poverty will speak on the evening of February 2.
- Calvary will host the pre-council meeting for the Southwest Convocation on Sunday afternoon, February 4, 2018. Amber Zentis and Kathy Haley are co-chairing the organization of the pre-meeting.

Curate's Report

- Rev. Lecia shared that the Pastoral Care team has begun discussing their goals for next year.
- Nancy Wilkes, Calvary's deacon-in-training, gave a presentation to the Pastoral Care team on confidentiality.
- A 'Blue Service' (a Service of Hope) was held on December 3rd. There were 52 attendees.
- Rev. Lecia is also starting to plan the adult education programs for next year.

Sr. Warden Report

• Sr. Warden Jewlon Morris reported on a presentation given by the Fort Bend Sheriff's office on church security.

Jr. Warden Report

- Jr. Warden Terry Jordan reported on several items:
 - o Brian Gamble caulked/sealed/repaired the frame around the 'Jesus Window.' Oscar Lozano helped him with the effort.
 - A quote was received for repairing the gutter on the 2nd story portion of the school. Terry is in discussion with the school about how to move forward.
 - A new Hobart commercial dishwasher has been ordered. A Calvary family and the Calvary Foundation agreed to donate funds for the dishwasher, and last month, vestry approved \$1,000, if needed. This additional \$1,000 is not needed.
 - Flood control: A new flood assessment study by Costello Engineering and Surveying is not yet complete. Calvary will have to wait for it to be finalized before receiving a copy. Fr. Paul reported that Costello Engineering and Surveying will be making a presentation to the City of Rosenberg next Monday, December 18.
- Further details of ongoing projects are in the Jr. Warden's report (see the vestry packet).
